## BIODIVERSITY + ECOLOGY STRATEGY

The biodiversity strategy focuses on enhancement and management of the existing natural resources and habitats on the site. In the development areas, new plantings will be carefully selected to promote greater biodiversity, support pollinator species and provide new habitats. Insect hotels, log piles, and bird and bat boxes will also be strategically placed to further enhance habitat provision on site.
